Bucklands Beach Road / Sunderlands Road Intersection Improvements - Stage 1

Aucklanders have told us that moving around our city safely and easily is important to them.

We have to cover a lot of ground – from looking after roads and footpaths, to cycling routes, parking, public transport and most importantly our people.

The work we're doing

We're doing this work to maintain and improve your neighbourhood and to keep customers safe. The drawings show where we'll be working.

The work involves:

- Stage 1 Reconstruction of Footpaths, Vehicle Crossings, Kerb and Channel
- Stage 2 Installation of new drainage assets
- Stage 3 Installation of speed tables, roundabout, and pavement upgrades.

We'll do our best to start the work on time. Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we'll notify you.

We know our work can be a bit loud, and that noise – particularly at night – can be disrupting. We'll do our best to keep noise levels down. Any concerns will be managed and responded to by a Fulton Hogan representative.

We'll handle traffic flow in and out of the area, and any detours

We will use a mix of temporary traffic signs (like keep left arrows). We do this to keep traffic moving, and keep people who use the roads and footpaths safe. Traffic controllers will help to manage vehicle access. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions.

On-street parking will be limited while we carry out the work. You may need to either park on your property or on a side road and walk to your property.





Please take note-

- The work will involve machinery, which can be noisy, cause vibration and create dust. We will, however, use industry best practice to keep this to a minimum.
- Please expect some delays when accessing your property when machinery is working immediately in front of driveways. Vehicle access into driveways will be blocked at certain times.
- AT Metro Bus users, please follow the signs to a temporary bus stop if your regular bus stop is closed. Please approach our friendly traffic controllers if unclear.
- For your safety, please keep young children and animals well supervised and clear of any work area.

The works will be undertaken as quickly and quietly as possible to minimise the number of days worked and disruption caused to neighbours and businesses. The works will be completed in accordance with the Auckland Unitary Plan.
