IMPORTANT INFORMATION – Please read the following notes

1. Shaded Courses *. These courses do not lead to approved subjects for University Entrance. They may include a mixture of Achievement Standards and Unit Standards. Students selecting one or more of these courses must see Mrs Thompson.
2. Level 2 Drama. This course may be timetabled with Level 3 Drama.
3. Students can only study a maximum of two of Level 2 Art Photography, Art Design, Art Painting and Design & Visual Communication. See Mrs Thompson, Year 12 Dean.
4. Level 2 Technologies. Students who wish to study more than one of Level 2 Early Childhood Studies, Construction and Engineering Mechanical must see Mrs Thompson, Year 12 Dean, before completing subject selection on-line. Construction may be timetabled with Level 3.
5. Level 2 Spanish. Students may be able to study Level 2 Spanish on a case by case basis. See Head of Department, Languages, Mr Rodriguez. This class will be combined with Cambridge Spanish.
6. Level 2 Textiles. This course will be timetabled with Level 3 Textiles.
7. Level 2 English for Literacy. Students who previously studied 11ENL must select this course. See on-line details.
8. Level 2 Music. This course may be timetabled with Level 1 and Level 3 Music.
9. Level 2 Māori. This course may be timetabled with Level 1 Māori and will be offered subject to numbers.
10. Year 12 Japanese is offered under the Cambridge International qualifications and may be timetabled with IGCSE Japanese. See Head of Department, Languages, Mr Rodriguez.
11. Level 2 Mathematics Continuing (12MAT) and Mathematics (12MST). Students wishing to study Level 3 Mathematics must choose 12MAT. Note: 12MST is not designed to lead to Level 3 Mathematics in Year 13. See on-line subject details.
12. Level 2 Vocational Studies. Entry to this course is by selection. See Mrs Thompson, Year 12 Dean or Mrs Bushe, Careers Advisor.
13. Level 2 Digital Technologies Computing and Robotics & Product Design will be offered subject to numbers and may be a combined class with Level 1 and/or 3.
14. Level 2 Dance. This course may be timetabled with Level 1 and Level 3.
15. Students can only study a maximum of two of Level 2 Accounting, Business Studies and Economics.
16. Level 2 Accounting. This course will be offered subject to numbers.
