3. Students can only choose 1 of:
AS Mathematics (12MAC) or AS Mathematics (12MTC)
4. Students can only choose 2 of:
11ACC, 11BSC, 11ECC
11CNC, 11JPC, 11SPC, 11MAO
Either 11ENC or 11ELC or 11ENG or 11ESL or 12ENC or 12ELC and 11MDS
5. Students can only choose up to 3 Sciences (11BIC, 11CHC, 11PYC, 12BIC, 12CHC, 12PYC) on approval of Mrs Bigwood, Year 11 Dean. See the Course Guide for approval guidelines.
6. Students cannot study 3 Sciences + 11ACC.
7. Students cannot study 3 Sciences + 11CPC.
8. Students cannot study 2 Sciences and both 11ACC and 11CPC.
9. Students can only study 1 of 11ARV & 11ADP (these Art courses are excellent preparation for AS Art in Yr 12).
10. Students can only study 1 of 11TCO, 11TEM, 11TEX, 11HPY & 11TRE.
11. Shaded Courses*. These courses do not lead to University Entrance approved NCEA subjects.
12. 11ARV, 11ADP, 11DAN, 11DRA, 11ENG, 11ESL, 11HPY, 11MAO, 11MAT, 11MDS, 11PEA, 11TCO, 11TEM, 11TEX, 11HPY, 11TRE are NCEA courses that are not offered under Cambridge.
13. 12MTC and 12MAC. The AS examinations for 12MTC will be sat in October 2019 and for 12MAC will be sat in October 2020. (Note: 11MAT is not designed to lead to AS Mathematics). See Course Guide.
14. AS Mathematics courses (12MTC and 12MAC) – see Course Guide for entry criteria. Students who sat IGCSE Mathematics in Year 10 have special entry criteria. Students selecting 12MAT must see Mrs Bigwood, Year 11 Dean.
15. IGCSE Japanese (11JPC) and Chinese (11CNC)
Japanese and Chinese will be offered subject to numbers and may be combined IGCSE and AS classes.
16. IGCSE Computer Programming (11CPC)
Students who did not study Computer Science in Year 10 will need to see Mrs Bigwood, Year 11 Dean before submitting their options.
17. NCEA Level 1 English (11ENG) and ESOL (11ESL).
These subjects lead to NCEA Level 2 (12ENG and 12ESL) not AS English Literature or AS English Language.
18. NCEA Level 1 Maori (11MAO)
This course will be offered subject to numbers and may be a combined class with Level 2 Maori.
19. NCEA Level 1 Robotics & Product Design (11TRE) will be offered subject to numbers and may be a combined class with Level 2.
20. NCEA Level 1 Dance may be a combined class with Level 2.
21. Students may study 11ENC or 11ELC if they did not study IGCSE English Literature (10ELC) in Year 10.
22. Students who sat IGCSE Combined Science and IGCSE English in Year 10 have special entry criteria. You cannot choose all three 12BIC, 12CHC and 12PYC. See Note 5.
23. 11MTC and 11MAT are courses for students who did not sit IGCSE Mathematics in Year 10.
(Note: 11MAT is not designed to lead to AS Mathematics). See Course Guide.
